- The Reno Chamber Orchestra (RCO) is a per-service employer with approximately 25-30 services per season. The current rate for section musicians in the 2026-27 season is \$127.20/service. Section Bass shall also receive cartage at \$10.00/concert set.
- Please note that outside of mileage reimbursement¹, these Section positions **do NOT provide reimbursement for travel or housing** — travel and housing are the sole responsibility of the individual.

Travel Information

The closest airport is Reno-Tahoe International Airport (RNO), and the auditions will be held at the University of Nevada, Reno campus. **Please do NOT book your travel to Reno until you have been invited to audition!**

Eligibility Requirements

Applicant musicians must display relevant career experience on their resume² and be authorized to work in the United States. RCO employees must also complete an I-9 and provide corresponding documentation when they begin work, which could consist of a trial period. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of a position and/or trial period, and the RCO will not delay the start date of these positions or the trial period to secure documentation. The RCO also cannot assist with visa petitions, visa renewals, work authorization, or similar documentation.

¹ CBA Section 11.1: "The Employer shall pay transportation costs for each member traveling between 15 and 60 miles from their residence to the place of a public performance or rehearsal. Travel mileage shall be reimbursed at the Government Standard Allowance."
