- The Reno Chamber Orchestra (RCO) is a per-service employer with approximately 30-40 services per season. The current per-service rate for section musicians in the 2025-26 season is \$120.00, with principal musicians receiving 120% of the section rate.
- Please note that the RCO will **reimburse up to \$300.00 for domestic travel and provide housing for the Principal 2nd Violin position ONLY** — for Section Violin contracts, travel and housing are the sole responsibility of the individual.

### Travel Information

The closest airport is Reno-Tahoe International Airport (RNO), and the auditions will be held on the University of Nevada, Reno campus. **Please do NOT book your travel to Reno until you have been invited to audition!**

### Eligibility Requirements

Applicant musicians must display relevant career experience on their resume<sup>1</sup> and be authorized to work in the United States. RCO employees must also complete an I-9 and provide corresponding documentation when they begin work, which could consist of a trial period. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of a position and/or trial period, and the RCO will not delay the start date of these positions
